

Clinical II/Internship II (full time) Student Teaching Application Process

- 1. The Orientation information can be found at the bottom of our homepage https://step.tcnj.edu
- 2. Read "Policies" for student teaching. You must have a GPA of 3.0 to student teach.
- 3. Click on the "Apply" button on the homepage.
- 4. Login with your TCNJ username and password.
- 5. Complete Student Teaching Profile.
- 6. Select and complete the appropriate application. After you submit the application(s), print a copy of the completed application(s). You will have space to sign the document.

Students interested in Global Student teaching will need two online applications, one for global and one for their US placement. Students in the K-6 Deaf Education will need to complete two online applications (one for DFHH 690 and one for ELEM 695). The following hard.copy documents must be submitted to your department** for approval before the deadlines indicated:

- a. 1 copy of the Student Teaching Online Application(s)
- b. 1 copy of your educational resume
- c. 1 copy of your Unofficial Transcript (from PAWS)
- d. 1 copy of Fingerprints (if available)-use substitute teacher option
- e. 1 copy of current Negative Mantoux Test (TB) (if available)
- f. 1 copy of Substitute Certificate (if available)
