Clinical II/Student Teaching Application Process

The following information will assist you to begin the process for clinical II/student teaching application.

- 1. Visit the Clinical Experience/Practice Information page at: https://step.tcnj.edu
- 2. Be sure to read "Policies" and "Prerequisites" for student teaching. If you should have questions concerning any of these policies including the minimum required cumulative **GPA of 3.0**, please speak with your department coordinator or the STEP Office. (Students with a GPA between 2.75 and 2.99 may be eligible to student teach with departmental recommendation.) Students must possess a final cumulative GPA of 3.00 or greater in order to obtain a TCNJ certification recommendation.)
- 3- Click on "Student Teaching Applications"
- 4- Login with your TCNJ user name and password.
- 5- Complete Student Teaching Profile.
- 6- Select and complete the appropriate application.Be sure to print the completed application after you click the submit button.

7- The following hard copy documents must be submitted to your department for approval before the deadlines indicated:

- 1 copy of the Student Teaching Application(s)
- 1 copy of your educational resume
- 1 copy of your Unofficial Transcript (on PAWS)
- 1 copy of current Negative Mantoux Test (TB) (if available)
- 1 copy of Substitute Certificate (if available)

Proof of Praxis II test; must be presented to your department coordinator prior to student teaching.

All applications must be turned into your department coordinator by *December 07, 2018*.
